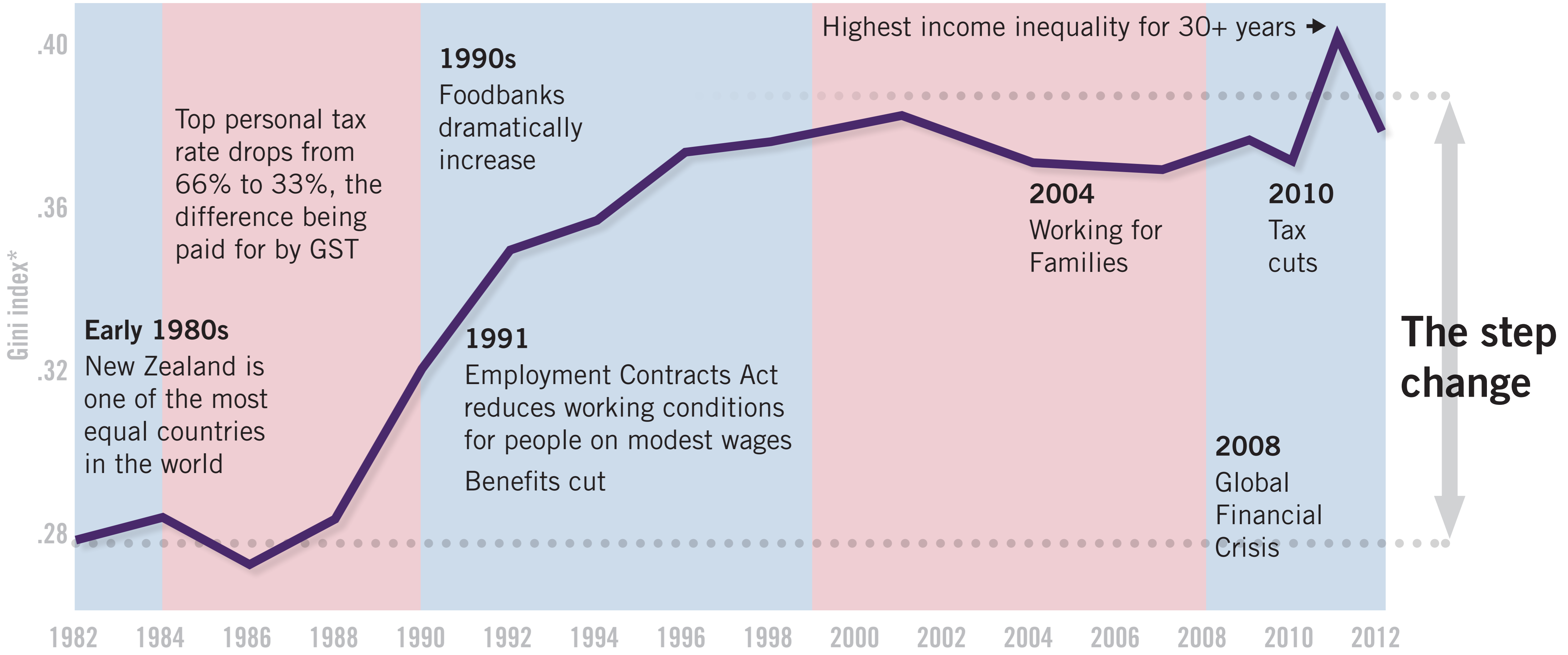


30 years of inequality in New Zealand

*The Gini index represents the spread of incomes in a country. In a country with a Gini index of 0, everyone would receive an equal income. In a country with a Gini index of 1, just one person would receive all the income.
